

# DON CICCIO AMARI 12 / Neat | 15 / Spritz

The story of Don Ciccio and the Amadeo family that produces these liqueurs dates to 1852 from the small town of Atrani along the Amalfi coast. The original "Don" - Francesco, invented the recipes for a wide array of family liqueurs and ran a thriving small distillery until the first World War. Shuttered due to shortages of necessary ingredients until the 1950's, the operation springs back to life, operating in southern Italy for 30 years until a massive earthquake in Irpinia destroys the distillery and the surrounding lemon groves and gardens it depends on. Yet the family carried on, moving to America and settling in the Washington D.C. area, always carrying the old family liqueur recipes with them until they get a chance for rebirth by opening a new distillery in the new world. Now working as a small batch operation with vessels including amphora and wine barrels from the Amalfi Coast and sourcing organic bases for all their liqueurs, this modern line of amari are sure to delight as apertifs (especially as spritzes) or digestifs.
